

## **Student Visas**

Studying Spanish can qualify you for a long-term student visa. At TEFL Iberia, we have extensive experience guiding students through the Spanish student visa process, and aim to make the process as easy as possible.



#### Do I need a visa?

If you are not from the European Union and wish to stay in Spain for more than 90 days, you'll need a student visa.



## What are the requirements?

To apply, you'll need to enroll in a course with at least 20 hours of study per week. Additionally, you'll require a valid passport, a criminal background check, a medical report, proof of financial support for your stay, medical insurance, and an invitation letter from our school. ## Accommodation

Safety and comfort are our top priority for your accommodation. All of our apartments are located within 30 minutes of the school, either by walking or public transport.



## Share an apartment with your classmates

You'll have your own room in a shared apartment, normally with 3-4 bedrooms total. All apartments are fully equipped and ready to move in. You'll have space to study, bedding, privacy, wifi, use of all the kitchen and a shared bathroom.



## Access to a resident assistant

To ensure your safety, each flat has a resident assistant. They are a few years older, speak Spanish and have lived in Barcelona for at least a year. They will be on hand for any immediate assistance you need at home.

## **FAQs**

## This is my first time living away from home on my own. Will I have support in case I am having a difficult time adjusting?

Yes! We understand that most of our students will be living away from home for the first time, and in a foreign country. While this is a very exciting time in your life, it can also be intimidating and challenging to navigate. With our 24/7 support line, dedicated coordinators for Gap Year students and mandatory orientation sessions, you can rest assured that you will not be in this alone!

#### Can I get college credit for my courses?

The short answer is it depends. The education system in the United States is very decentralized, and each University has its own set of rules for accepting international education for credit hours. That said - the DELE exam is awarded by the Instituto Cervantes on behalf of the Spanish Ministry of Education and Vocational Training. It is an official certificate that demonstrates your level of Spanish, which can in some cases be used to skip credit hours of language learning at University. As for the Trinity CertTESOL certificate, it truly depends on your University and if they will homologate the course hours into credits. Our staff is here to help you navigate this process should you need any support.

## (Pioneer Program only) How much can I expect to earn teaching English in Barcelona?

On average, teachers earns about €15 an hour.
On a long-term student visa, you can work up to
30 hours per week. However we do suggest
working no more than 25, as we've seen that
this is the sweet spot to earning a comfortable
salary, and not overwhelming yourself!

## I learned Latin American Spanish in high school. Is the Spanish taught in Spain very different?

No! Just like American English and British English, Latin American Spanish and "Spain" Spanish are the same language. One thing to keep in mind is that Spanish is often referred to as castellano, or castilian, in Spain instead of the more commonly used español in the United States and Latin America.

#### How old will my peers be?

Our gap year program is exclusively for young adults between the ages of 18-22. You will be amongst others that are in a similar stage of life to yourself, making it very easy to form lifelong friendships and close bonds.

#### Can I bring my pet?

While we love pets, we unfortunately cannot accommodate them in the student housing. Unfortunately there are no exceptions for emotional support animals.

#### How will I get around?

Public transportation, and walking! Don't worry about not having your car, Barcelona is extremely well connected with public transportation and very walkable.

## I am Jewish. Is it safe for me in Spain with the current political climate? I'm worried about what I've seen on the news.

Yes. Barcelona is a cosmopolitan city that has a plethora of diversity of races and religions.
